SUMMARY: House Bill 1055, Printer's Number 1089, amends Act 37 of 1868 providing for the confidentiality of records and extends the time period when a veteran's records of discharge or separation may not be disclosed.

ANALYSIS: This bill amends Act 37 of 1868 to increase the required time county recorders of deeds may not disclose veterans' records of discharge, reports of separation or related documents from 75 to 85 years. Records would still be available to the individual who is the subject of the records, the individual's immediate family, an authorized representative, a court official or official government agency.

This legislation would take effect in 60 days upon enactment.

FISCAL IMPACT: Enactment of this legislation will have no impact on Commonwealth funds.
