**SUMMARY**: House Bill 1774, Printer's Number 2149, amends the Achieving Better Care by Monitoring All Prescriptions Program (ABC-MAP) Act to add additional authorized users and extend the expiration date of the act. This legislation is effective immediately.

**ANALYSIS**: HB 1774 adds Commonwealth personnel and contracted staff who are responsible for Catastrophic Loss Benefits Continuation Fund and Workers' Compensation Security Fund programs, as well as Department of Labor and Industry personnel engaged in the administration and regulation of medical fee review disputes and utilization review of medical treatment under the Workers' Compensation Act, to the list of authorized users of the prescription monitoring system. The bill also extends the expiration of the ABC-MAP Act from June 30, 2022 to December 31, 2028.

**FISCAL IMPACT**: Enactment of this legislation will have no adverse fiscal impact on Commonwealth funds.
