#### **SUMMARY:**

Clarifies that an individual who attempts, conspires, or solicits to commit an offense under the Sexual Offender Registration Act (SORNA) will be required to register under SORNA.

#### ANALYSIS:

Senate Bill 1111 amends the definition of "Sexually violent predator" in Section 9799.12 of Title 42 (Judiciary and Judicial Procedure) to include anyone who committed, or attempted, conspired, or solicited to commit a sexually violent offense under the laws of the Commonwealth.

The legislation further clarifies that all Tier I, II, and III offenses under Title 42, Section 9799.14 (Sexual offenses and tier system), include the enumerated offenses or the attempt, conspiracy, or solicitation to commit such offenses.

This legislation would take effect immediately upon enactment.

### FISCAL IMPACT:

Enactment of this legislation will have no impact on Commonwealth funds. According to the Sexual Offenders Assessment Board, additional investigations and assessments that could occur as a result of this legislation are unlikely to require additional staff.
