House Bill 2296 provides for the Commonwealth's nonpreferred appropriation to the University of Pennsylvania for FY 2010-11.

The bill specifies \$30,000,000 shall be provided for Veterinary Activities and \$500,000 for the Center for Infectious Diseases.

Payments to the University are to be made quarterly and the bill is scheduled to take effect July 1, or immediately, whichever is later.

FISCAL IMPACT:

The bill appropriates a total of \$30,500,000 in funds to the University in FY 2010-11.
