DESCRIPTION AND PURPOSE OF BILL

Senate Bill 1196 amends the Bituminous Mine Subsidence and Land Conservation Act. The current law allows the Department of Environmental Protection to collect filing fees for permit applications. The bill will allow the Environmental Quality Board to adjust that fee by regulation.
