DESCRIPTION AND PURPOSE OF BILL

Senate Bill 1059 appropriates \$58,898,000 in state funds from a restricted revenue account within the General Fund and \$3,900,000 in federal funds to the Public Utility Commission ("PUC") for its operations for fiscal year 2011-12.

The FY 2011-12 federal appropriation of \$3,900,000 consists of \$1,501,000 for natural gas pipeline safety, \$1,888,000 for motor carrier safety, and \$511,000 for electric regulatory assistance under ARRA.

Senate Bill 1059 reflects the Governor's recommended FY 2011-12 budget of \$58,898,000 for the PUC. This is a \$2,895,000 increase (5.2%) over the FY 2010-11 appropriation of \$56,003,000.

The PUC is funded by assessments of public utilities. Subject to budgetary approval, the Public Utility Commission may assess up to three-tenths of one percent of gross intrastate revenues to cover the cost of regulation.

This act shall take effect July 1, 2011, or immediately, whichever is later.
