DESCRIPTION AND PURPOSE OF BILL

House Bill 1192 is the General Appropriation Act of 2015, which provides for the expenses of the Executive, Legislative and Judicial Departments of the Commonwealth, the public debt and for the public schools for the fiscal year July 1, 2015 to June 30, 2016. General Fund and federal augmenting appropriations total \$29,592,883 and \$24,184,396 respectively.

The bill also makes state appropriations for a variety of special funds which are summarized in the following chart:
