DESCRIPTION AND PURPOSE OF BILL

Senate Bill 1073, printer's number 2000, as amended, is the General Appropriation Act of 2016, which provides for the expenses of the Executive, Legislative and Judicial Departments of the Commonwealth, the public debt and for the public schools for the fiscal year July 1, 2016 to June 30, 2017. General Fund and federal augmenting appropriations total \$30,918,151,000 and \$26,208,888,000 respectively.
