AN ACT

- 1 Amending the act of February 22, 1855 (P.L.46, No.50), entitled
- 2 "An act to incorporate the Farmers' High School of
- Pennsylvania, " further providing for management by board of
- 4 trustees.
- 5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 6 hereby enacts as follows:
- 7 Section 1. Section 2 of the act of February 22, 1855
- 8 (P.L.46, No.50), entitled "An act to incorporate the Farmers'
- 9 High School of Pennsylvania, " is amended to read:
- 10 Section 2. Management by board of trustees
- 11 (a) The said institution shall be under the management and
- 12 government of a board of trustees[, of whom there shall be
- 13 thirteen, and seven of whom shall be a quorum, competent to
- 14 perform the duties hereinafter authorized and required.] that
- 15 <u>shall be comprised of a total of twenty-two trustees</u>, which
- 16 shall include eighteen voting trustees, three voting trustees ex
- 17 officio and one nonvoting trustee ex officio.
- 18 (1) The composition of said board shall reflect the overall

- 1 <u>interests and expertise of the following officials and entities:</u>
- 2 (i) The Governor, who shall be the nonvoting trustee ex
- 3 officio.
- 4 (ii) The Secretary of Agriculture.
- 5 (iii) The Secretary of Conservation and Natural Resources.
- 6 (iv) The Secretary of Education.
- 7 (v) The Pennsylvania State University alumni.
- 8 (vi) Pennsylvania county agricultural societies.
- 9 (vii) Pennsylvania business and industry groups.
- 10 (2) Business and industry trustees shall only be elected by
- 11 members of geographically dispersed Pennsylvania business and
- 12 <u>industry associations; at least two of these trustees shall</u>
- 13 represent the fields of engineering, mining, manufacturing and
- 14 architecture.
- 15 (3) Prospective members of the board of trustees who shall
- 16 represent the interests and expertise of school alumni,
- 17 agriculture and business and industry shall only be elected by
- 18 the following entities:
- 19 <u>(i) The Pennsylvania State University alumni.</u>
- 20 (ii) Pennsylvania county agriculture societies.
- 21 (iii) Pennsylvania business and industry groups.
- 22 (4) A simple majority of the voting members of the board of
- 23 trustees shall constitute a quorum and is required prior to any
- 24 official action to be taken by the board.
- 25 (5) Members of the board of trustees shall either be elected
- 26 or appointed for a term of three years. No member shall serve
- 27 more than an aggregate limit of nine years on the board of
- 28 trustees during the course of his lifetime.
- 29 (b) The provisions of this section shall be applicable to
- 30 both current and prospective members of The Pennsylvania State

- 1 <u>University board of trustees.</u>
 - 2 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
