AN ACT

- 1 Amending the act of March 24, 1905 (P.L.50, No.35), entitled,
- 2 "An act to reorganize the Board of Trustees of The
- Pennsylvania State College, "further providing for the Board
- 4 of Trustees.
- 5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 6 hereby enacts as follows:
- 7 Section 1. Section 1 of the act of March 24, 1905 (P.L.50,
- 8 No.35), entitled, "An act to reorganize the Board of Trustees of ...
- 9 The Pennsylvania State College, "amended June 24, 1939 (P.L.863,
- 10 No.367), is amended to read:
- 11 Section 1. Be it enacted, &c., That, in addition to the
- 12 present elective members of the Board of Trustees of The
- 13 Pennsylvania State College, the said Board shall consist of the
- 14 following members, to wit: Three members to be elected each
- 15 year, for a term of three years each, by the alumni of said
- 16 college; and two members to be appointed each year, for a term
- 17 of three years each, by the Governor of the Commonwealth, and
- 18 confirmed by the Senate [; and the following members to serve

- 1 ex-officio during their respective terms of office: The Governor
- 2 of the Commonwealth, the President of the College, the State
- 3 Superintendent of Public Instruction, the Secretary of
- 4 Agriculture, and the Secretary of Mines].
- 5 (1) The Governor, the Secretary of Education, the Secretary
- 6 of Agriculture and the Secretary of Conservation and Natural
- 7 Resources shall serve ex officio during their respective terms.
- 8 (2) Board members shall serve as voting members ex officio,
- 9 <u>except the Governor, who shall serve as a nonvoting member ex</u>
- 10 officio.
- 11 (3) No person who has served in the capacity of the
- 12 Governor, Lieutenant Governor, Attorney General, Auditor General
- 13 or State Treasurer shall be permitted to serve on the Board of
- 14 Trustees as a voting member until at least four years have
- 15 elapsed following his official departure from that office.
- 16 Section 2. Section 3 of the act is amended to read:
- 17 Section 3. [The officers of the Board shall be chosen
- 18 annually, to serve for a period of one year each; and shall be a
- 19 President, a Vice-President, a Secretary, a Treasurer, and an
- 20 Executive Committee of not less than three nor more than seven
- 21 members, whose duty it shall be, under the direction and subject
- 22 to the approval of the Board of Trustees, to transact such
- 23 necessary business as may arise in the intervals between regular
- 24 meetings of the Board. No member of the Board shall receive
- 25 compensation for his services; but shall be paid necessary
- 26 traveling and hotel expenses actually incurred in the
- 27 performance of duty as such member. The Treasurer shall not be a
- 28 member of the board, and shall give such bonds for the faithful
- 29 performance of his duties, and receive such compensation as the
- 30 Board may, from time to time, direct.] (a) The officers of the

- 1 Board shall be elected annually, to serve for a one-year term
- 2 and shall include a chair, a vice-chair, a secretary, a
- 3 treasurer and an executive committee of not less than three nor
- 4 more than seven members, whose duty it shall be, under the
- 5 direction and subject to the approval of the Board of Trustees,
- 6 to transact such necessary business as may arise in the
- 7 <u>intervals between regular meetings</u> of the Board. No member of
- 8 the Board shall receive compensation for his services but shall
- 9 be paid necessary traveling and hotel expenses actually incurred
- 10 in the performance of duty as such member. The treasurer shall
- 11 not be a member of the Board, and shall give such bonds for the
- 12 <u>faithful performance of his duties</u>, and receive such
- 13 compensation as the Board may, from time to time, direct.
- 14 (b) The President of the college shall be prohibited from
- 15 serving as an officer of the Board of Trustees, and shall also
- 16 be prohibited from serving on the executive committee, any
- 17 standing committee, special committee or subcommittee of the
- 18 Board.
- 19 Section 3. The amendments of sections 1 and 3 of the act
- 20 shall be applicable to both current and prospective members of
- 21 The Pennsylvania State University Board of Trustees.
- 22 Section 4. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
