## AN ACT

- 1 Amending Title 65 (Public Officers) of the Pennsylvania
- 2 Consolidated Statutes, in ethics standards and financial
- disclosure, further providing for definitions.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. The definitions of "governmental body,"
- 7 "governmental body with which a public official or public
- 8 employee is or has been associated" and "public employee" in
- 9 section 1102 of Title 65 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- 10 Statutes are amended and the section is amended by adding a
- 11 definition to read:
- 12 § 1102. Definitions.
- 13 The following words and phrases when used in this chapter
- 14 shall have, unless the context clearly indicates otherwise, the
- 15 meanings given to them in this section:
- 16 \* \* \*
- "Governmental body." Any department, authority, commission,
- 18 committee, council, board, bureau, division, service, office,

- 1 officer, administration, legislative body or other establishment
- 2 in the executive, legislative or judicial branch of a state, a
- 3 nation or a political subdivision thereof [or], any agency
- 4 performing a governmental function or a State-related
- 5 institution and its affiliates.
- 6 "Governmental body with which a public official or public
- 7 employee is or has been associated." The governmental body
- 8 within State government, a State-related institution and its
- 9 <u>affiliates</u> or a political subdivision by which the public
- 10 official or employee is or has been employed or to which the
- 11 public official or employee is or has been appointed or elected
- 12 and subdivisions and offices within that governmental body.
- 13 \* \* \*
- "Public employee." Any individual employed by the
- 15 Commonwealth, a State-related institution and its affiliates or
- 16 a political subdivision who is responsible for taking or
- 17 recommending official action of a nonministerial nature with
- 18 regard to:
- 19 (1) contracting or procurement;
- 20 (2) administering or monitoring grants or subsidies;
- 21 (3) planning or zoning;
- 22 (4) inspecting, licensing, regulating or auditing any
- 23 person; or
- 24 (5) any other activity where the official action has an
- economic impact of greater than a de minimis nature on the
- interests of any person.
- 27 The term shall not include individuals who are employed by this
- 28 Commonwealth or any political subdivision thereof in teaching as
- 29 distinguished from administrative duties.
- 30 \* \* \*

- 1 <u>"State-related institution and its affiliates." The</u>
- 2 Pennsylvania State University, including the Pennsylvania
- 3 College of Technology, Temple University, the University of
- 4 Pittsburgh and Lincoln University serving as instrumentalities
- 5 of the Commonwealth within the Commonwealth system of higher
- 6 education. The term also includes any of their graduate schools,
- 7 <u>law schools, medical schools, continental and international</u>
- 8 branch campuses, as applicable, and any associated hospital,
- 9 medical center, institute, facility, subsidiary or subordinate
- 10 unit.
- 11 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
