BURGESS - DEFINITION AS BOROUGH MAYOR Act of May 23, 1961, P.L. 210, No. 109 Cl. 08

AN ACT

Amending the act of May 4, 1927 (P.L.519), entitled "An act concerning boroughs, and revising, amending, and consolidating the law relating to boroughs," redesignating the burgess as the mayor.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 2. "Burgess" means mayor. -- Whenever in any law the word burgess is used, it shall be deemed to mean mayor of a borough.
