MARTIN LUTHER KING, JR., EXPRESSWAY - DESIGNATION Act of Nov. 21, 1988, P.L. 1080, No. 123 AN ACT

Designating a certain portion of U.S. Route 1 in Bucks County as the Martin Luther King, Jr., Expressway.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. Designation.

That portion of the U.S. Route 1 Expressway (Legislative Route No. 281) from the interchange with the Pennsylvania Turnpike in Bensalem Township to the interchange of U.S. Route 1 at the State boundary with New Jersey shall hereafter be known as the Martin Luther King, Jr., Expressway. Section 2. Appropriate signs.

The Department of Transportation shall erect the appropriate signs to indicate this highway designation to the motoring public.

Section 3. Effective date. This act shall take effect immediately.
