(Representatives SONNEY, V. BROWN, D. COSTA and others) - **Ageing & Older Adult Services, May 23, 2017** **1**

This bill amends the State Lottery Law to exclude from the definition of "income" the principal and any interest accrued from a savings bond in determination of eligibility for PACE and PACENET.

This bill provides for short title and scope of chapter and for appeals by taxing districts.

(Representatives DAY, KNOWLES, D. COSTA and others) - **Consumer Affairs, May 22, 2017** **2**

This bill amends Title 66 to increase penalties for unlicensed household goods movers operating in the Commonwealth.

This bill amends the Human Services Code to require a uniform distribution of SNAP benefits over a 25-day distribution schedule.

This bill is a summary of proposed legislation and is prepared only as general information for use by the Republican Members and staff of the Pennsylvania House of Representatives.

This bill amends the Protection From Abuse Act to add another type of relief for the plaintiff by allowing the court to order the defendant to refrain from abusing the plaintiff's cat or dog.

This bill amends Title 72 to remove future employees of the Susquehanna River Basin Commission for the State Employees Retirement System.

An Act amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in size, weight and load, further providing for maximum gross weight of vehicles. (Representatives METZGAR, SANKEY, WARD and others) - **Transportation, May 23, 2017** **1**

This bill amends Title 75 by providing a weight exemption for natural gas vehicles to exceed the gross vehicle weight and axle weight limit, by no more than 2,000 pounds.

This bill amends the Vehicle Code to create a tiered penalty system for driving on a suspended license as a result of a DUI.
