This bill extends a moratorium on increases in income due to a Social Security cost-of-living adjustment for certain individuals enrolled in PACE and PACENET.

This bill provides for short title and scope of chapter and for appeals by taxing districts.

This bill amends the Game and Wildlife Code to expand Pennsylvania's mentored hunting programs to include junior hunters aged 12 to 17 years old.

This bill amends the Local Option Small Games of Chance Act to allow non-profits affiliated with an international airport to hold 50/50 raffles within the airport.
