*This bill amends the Protection From Abuse Act to add another type of relief for the plaintiff by allowing the court to order the defendant to refrain from abusing the plaintiff's cat or dog.*

**An Act amending the act of November 10, 1999 (P.L.491, No.45), known as the Pennsylvania Construction Code Act, in adoption and enforcement by municipalities, further providing for administration and enforcement.** (Representatives HEFFLEY, McGINNIS, MILLARD and others) - **Rules, June 21, 2017** **5**

*This bill amends the PA Construction Code Act to require that building permit applications in municipalities using one or more third party agency to enforce the Uniform Construction Code, contain a written notice on where complaints can be directed about the performance of such agencies.*

**An Act amending the act of April 12, 1951 (P.L.90, No.21), known as the Liquor Code, in preliminary provisions, further defining "alcoholic cider" and "public venue"; and, in licenses and regulations for liquor, alcohol and malt and brewed beverages, further providing for wine and spirits auction permits.** (Representatives JOZWIAK, TALLMAN, ROTHMAN and others) - **Rules, June 28, 2017** **1**

*This bill amends the Liquor Code to align PA's definition of alcoholic cider with federal definition.*

*This bill establishes an Optional Senior Property Tax Freeze program.*

*This bill creates a freestanding act known as the Home Inspector Licensing Act to establish the Home Inspector Licensing Board within the Department of Labor and Industry.*

**An Act amending the act of June 19, 1931 (P.L.589, No.202), referred to as the Barbers' License Law, further providing for definitions. (Representatives STURLA, ROZZI, RABB and others) - Rules, June 28, 2017** **1**

*This bill amends the Barbers' License Law to allow barbers to practice outside of a licensed barber shop provided they accept no compensation for that work.*

*This bill provides for registration, for reporting, for prohibited activities, for penalties and for registration fees, fund established, system and regulations.*
