This bill requires students to take a locally developed assessment in civics between grades seven and twelve.

(Representatives ENGLISH, MILLARD, D. COSTA and others) - Appropriations, April 16, 2018

This bill allows for the use of sunscreen by students during school hours or at a school-sponsored event.

This bill amends the Tax Reform Code to increase the amount of available tax credits in the Neighborhood Assistance Program.

This bill amends the Abortion Control Act to prohibit abortion based on a diagnosis of Down Syndrome.

This bill amends Title 8 to standardize the process for billing municipal electric customers in boroughs situate in more than one county.

(Representatives SACCONI, J. HARRIS, ROTHMAN and others) - Appropriations, April 16, 2018 Fiscal-Note Attached 1

This bill removes language relating to federally mandated driver's license suspensions for drug/controlled substance convictions, as well as state-imposed suspensions for six other crimes.

An Act amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in certificate of title and security interests, further providing for content and effect of certificate of title and for theft vehicles; and making an editorial change. (Representatives MARSHALL, BENNINGHOFF, V. BROWN and others) - Appropriations, April 16, 2018 Fiscal-Note Attached 1

This bill limits when a vehicle owner must apply for a certificate of title branded as a theft vehicle and establishes restrictions for self-insurers.
