An Act amending the act of April 9, 1929 (P.L.177, No.175), known as The Administrative Code of 1929, in powers and duties of the Department of Labor and Industry, its departmental administrative and advisory boards and departmental administrative officers, further providing for fees and for Industrial Board and establishing the Elevator Safety Board. (Senators BAKER, YUDICHAK, LEACH and others) - Appropriations, June 21, 2018

This bill amends the Administrative Code to establish an "Elevator Safety Board" which will have specific jurisdiction over elevator appeals/variances and make recommendations on regulations.

This bill permits incorporated towns to purchase used personal property from volunteer emergency service organizations without bid.

An Act amending the act of July 9, 1987 (P.L.220, No.39), known as the Social Workers, Marriage and Family Therapists and Professional Counselors Act, further providing for definitions, for qualifications for license, for reciprocity, for restriction on the use of title "licensed clinical social worker," for restrictions on the use of title "Licensed Professional Counselor," for penalties and for unlawful practice; and repealing provisions related to appropriation. (Senators KILLION, BLAKE, ARGALL and others) - **Appropriations, June 21, 2018 Fiscal-Note Attached 1**

This bill amends the Social Workers, Marriage and Family Therapists and Professional Counselors Act to require individuals who engage in the independent practice of clinical social work, marriage and family therapy or professional counseling to be licensed.

This bill amends Title 71 by adding a new Part II to the law to transfer duties from the Civil Service commission to the Office of Administration.
