An Act amending Title 53 (Municipalities Generally) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in municipal authorities, further providing for definitions and for purposes and powers. (Senators FONTANA, McILHINNEY, RESCHENTHALER and others) - Local Government, June 29, 2017 By Rep. HARPER

This bill amends the Authorities Act to allow the use of public funds to replace private laterals.
