WEDNESDAY, June 14, 1995

The Senate met at 11 a.m., Eastern Daylight Saving Time.

The PRESIDENT (Lieutenant Governor Mark S. Schweiker) in the Chair.

PRAYER

JOURNAL APPROVED

BILLS ON SECOND CONSIDERATION AND REREFERRED

SB 83 (Pr. No. 145) -- The Senate proceeded to consideration of the bill, entitled:

An Act amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, further providing for exceptions to the interception and disclosure of communications by inmates of correctional institutions.

Considered the second time and agreed to, Ordered, To be printed for third consideration.

Upon motion of Senator LOEPER, and agreed to, the bill just considered was rereferred to the Committee on Appropriations.

SB 100 (Pr. No. 146) -- The Senate proceeded to consideration of the bill, entitled:

An Act amending Title 42 (Judiciary and Judicial Procedure) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, further defining "delinquent act" to exclude certain criminal offenses; and providing for children committing delinquent acts.

Considered the second time and agreed to, Ordered, To be printed for third consideration.

Upon motion of Senator LOEPER, and agreed to, the bill just considered was rereferred to the Committee on Appropriations.

SB 103 (Pr. No. 135) -- The Senate proceeded to consideration of the bill, entitled:

An Act providing for expedited eviction of drug traffickers; providing remedies; conferring powers and duties upon the Department of Health; and making an appropriation.

Considered the second time and agreed to,
Ordered, To be printed for third consideration.

Upon motion of Senator LOEPER, and agreed to, the bill just considered was rereferred to the Committee on Appropriations.

LEGISLATIVE LEAVE CANCELLED
