ELK COUNTY ERECTED Act of Apr. 18, 1843, P.L. 312, No. 150 Cl. 16

AN ACT

Erecting parts of Jefferson, Clearfield and M'Kean counties into a separate county, to be called Elk.

Section 4. Elk County.

The citizens of the County of Elk shall elect at the usual places of holding their general elections, in the same manner as heretofore, excepting as hereinbefore provided, until otherwise ordered by law. 1843, April 18, P.L. 312, Sec. 4.
