FARMERS PERMITTED TO SELL PRODUCE Act of Apr. 22, 1903, P.L. 258, No. 190 Cl. 11 AN ACT

To permit farmers to sell their own products without a licensefee, in and about the streets of any borough or city of this Commonwealth.

Section 1. Be it enacted, &c., That after the passage of this act, it shall be unlawful for any borough or city of this Commonwealth to levy or collect any money or tax, as a licensefee, from any farmer who sells his own products in or about the streets of any borough or city of this Commonwealth.
