

FIRST CLASS CITIES, PUBLIC PARKS
Act of Apr. 24, 1903, P.L. 294, No. 227

Authorizing commissioners in charge of public parks within cities of the first class of this Commonwealth to purchase, acquire, enter upon, take, use, and appropriate, for public park purposes, private property adjoining any public park within said cities, whenever, in their opinion, such property shall be necessary for the improvement of said park. (Title amended May 28, 1915, P.L.578, No.249)

Section 1. Be it enacted, &c., That commissioners in charge of public parks within cities of the first class of this Commonwealth are hereby authorized to purchase, acquire, enter upon, take, use, and appropriate, for public park purposes, private property adjoining any public park within said cities, whenever, in their opinion, such property shall be necessary for the improvement of said park.

Section 2. In exercising the power aforesaid, all proceedings for ascertaining damages, and assessing the benefits incident thereto, shall be in accordance with the law authorizing cities of this Commonwealth to acquire, by purchase or otherwise, private property for public park purposes.
