

CORONERS, FEES FIXED
Act of Mar. 27, 1929, P.L. 84, No. 95

To fix the fees to be charged by coroners in counties of the second and second A class. (Title amended Dec. 14, 1967, P.L.855, No.376)

Section 1. Be it enacted, &c., That from and after the passage of this act the fees to be received and charged by coroners in counties of the second and second A class in lieu of those now allowed by law shall be as follows, viz:

Viewing a dead body, seventy-five dollars (\$75.00).

Summoning inquest and returning inquisition, eight dollars (\$8.00).

Summoning or subpoenaing each witness, three dollars and fifty cents (\$3.50).

Qualifying each witness, two dollars and fifty cents (\$2.50).

Each mile circular traveled to be reckoned from the court house to the place of viewing the body, ten cents.
