DISTRICT ATTORNEY'S OFFICE, LAW BOOK PROVIDED Act of Apr. 10, 1929, P.L. 476, No. 193

AN ACT

Providing for the purchase of digests and law books for the offices of district attorneys of the Commonwealth by the boards of commissioners of counties, and for the payment of the same out of the funds of the county.

Compiler's Note: Section 26 of Act 146 of 1931 provided that Act 193 is repealed except insofar as it relates to counties of the first class.

Section 1. Be it enacted, &c., That the county commissioners of each county of the Commonwealth shall purchase, for the use of the office of the district attorney of such county, out of the funds of the county, a digest of the laws of the Commonwealth, and such books on evidence, criminal law, and criminal procedure as may be selected by the district attorney and approved by a judge of the court of said county.
