DEPARTMENT OF PARKS AND RECREATION IN SECOND CLASS CITIES Act of May 2, 1947, P.L. 142, No. 61

A SUPPLEMENT

To the act, approved the 7th day of March, one thousand nine hundred and one (Pamphlet Laws 20), entitled "An act for the government of cities of the second class," establishing a department of parks and recreation in said cities; providing for its officers and employees, and defining the powers, duties and jurisdiction of said department.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. That an additional department in the government of cities of the second class is hereby created to be known as the department of parks and recreation.

Section 2. The department of parks and recreation shall be under the charge of a director who shall be the head thereof. The supervision, equipping, operation, care and maintenance of parks, zoological gardens, conservatories, greenhouses, forestry, playgrounds, playfields, gymnasiums, public baths, swimming pools, and indoor recreation centers and the supervision of playleaders, recreation directors, supervisors, superintendents and any other officers or employes deemed proper for the purpose of carrying out the provisions of this act, shall be under the jurisdiction of this department.

Section 3. All the powers and duties as set forth in section 2 hereof, which are now under the jurisdiction of any other department of said city, are hereby transferred to the department of parks and recreation.
