## AUDITORS - COMPENSATION AND MILEAGE IN COUNTIES OF THE SIXTH, SEVENTH AND EIGHTH CLASSES

Act of Jun. 28, 1955, P.L. 206, No. 64 AN ACT Cl. 16

Fixing the compensation and mileage of county auditors in counties of the sixth, seventh and eighth classes.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. The county auditors in counties of the sixth, seventh and eighth classes shall receive ten dollars (\$10.00) for each day necessarily employed in the discharge of their duties, together with six cents per mile circular from and to their homes once each and every day so employed.
