## MUNICIPALITIES REIMBURSEMENT FOR GYPSY MOTH CONTROL Act of Apr. 29, 1982, P.L. 369, No. 103

AN ACT

Authorizing the Department of Environmental Resources to reimburse cooperating counties for a portion of each county's costs incurred under State-County-Federal gypsy moth programs and out of a Federal Augmentation appropriation made to the department.

Compiler's Note: Section 302(h) of Act 18 of 1995, which created the Department of Conservation and Natural Resources and renamed the Department of Environmental Resources as the Department of Environmental Protection, provided that the Department of Conservation and Natural Resources shall exercise the powers and duties conferred upon the Department of Environmental Resources by Act 103 of 1982.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. The Department of Environmental Resources shall reimburse to each cooperating county or municipality 23 1/2% of payments made to the State by said counties or municipalities pursuant to State-County-Federal cooperative agreements for gypsy moth control entered into during 1981. The moneys for said reimbursements shall be paid out of the Federal Augmentation appropriated to the department for gypsy moth control pursuant to the "Cooperative Forest Insect and Disease Control" appropriation in Part III, section 302 of the act of July 1, 1981 (P.L.628, No.5A), known as the "General Appropriation Act of 1981."

Compiler's Note: The Department of Environmental Resources, referred to in this section, was abolished by Act 18 of 1995. Its functions were transferred to the Department of Conservation and Natural Resources and the Department of Environmental Protection.

Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
