AN ACT

HB 502

Amending the act of February 1, 1966 (1965 P.L.1656, No.581),
entitled "An act concerning boroughs, and revising, amending
and consolidating the law relating to boroughs," further
providing for tax levies.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby
enacts as follows:

Section 1. Section 1302(8) of the act of February 1, 1966 (1965
P.L.1656, No.581), known as The Borough Code, is amended to read:

Section 1302. Tax Levy.--The council of the borough shall have
power, by ordinance, to levy and collect annually, a tax, not
exceeding thirty mills for general borough purposes, unless the
council by majority action shall, upon due cause shown by
resolution, petition the court of common pleas, in which case the
court may order a rate of not more than five mills additional to
be levied and in addition thereto any of the following taxes:

* * *

(8) To establish and/or maintain a local library or to maintain
or aid in the maintenance of a local library established by deed,
gift or testamentary provision, for the use of the residents of
the borough, [not exceeding three mills, such additional millage
permitted only following a favorable referendum on the matter held]
in accordance with the act of June 14, 1961 (P.L.324[]), **No.188**),
known as The Library Code.

Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
