## REPEAL - OBSOLETE LAW RELATING TO SPREAD OF RABIES, AUTHORIZATION TO QUARANTINE, RESTRAIN, CONFINE OR MUZZLE DOGS DURING OUTBREAKS OF RABIES AND POWERS OF STATE LIVE STOCK SANITARY BOARD

Repealing the act of March 27, 1903 (P.L.100, No.80), entitled "An act to prevent the spread of the disease known as rabies, or hydrophobia; and to authorize the quarantine, restraint, confinement, or muzzling of dogs, during outbreaks of this disease; and to empower the State Live Stock Sanitary Board to enforce the provisions of this act."

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. The act of March 27, 1903 (P.L.100, No.80), entitled "An act to prevent the spread of the disease known as rabies, or hydrophobia; and to authorize the quarantine, restraint, confinement, or muzzling of dogs, during outbreaks of this disease; and to empower the State Live Stock Sanitary Board to enforce the provisions of this act," is repealed. Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
