JOHN GROSS MEMORIAL BRIDGE - DESIGNATION AND PFC MELVIN L. BROWN MEMORIAL BRIDGE - REDESIGNATION

Act of May. 16, 2008, P.L. 151, No. 17 Cl. 36 AN ACT

Designating the bridge carrying State Route 1017, known as Lycoming Creek Road, over Bottle Run, Old Lycoming Township, Lycoming County, as the John Gross Memorial Bridge; and redesignating the bridge on State Route 36 in the Borough of Mahaffey, Clearfield County, as the PFC Melvin L. Brown Memorial Bridge.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. John Gross Memorial Bridge.

(a) Designation.--The bridge carrying State Route 1017, known as Lycoming Creek Road, over Bottle Run, Old Lycoming Township, Lycoming County, is designated and shall be known as the John Gross Memorial Bridge.

(b) Signs.--The Department of Transportation shall erect and maintain appropriate signs which shall display the name of the bridge designated in subsection (a) at each end of the bridge.

Section 2. PFC Melvin L. Brown Memorial Bridge.

(a) Redesignation.--The bridge on State Route 36 in the Borough of Mahaffey, Clearfield County, is redesignated the PFC Melvin L. Brown Memorial Bridge.

(b) Signs.--The Department of Transportation shall erect and maintain appropriate signs displaying the name of the bridge to traffic in both directions.

Section 3. Effective date.

This act shall take effect in 60 days.
