AN ACT

Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, further providing for special motorcycle plates for veterans.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. Section 1361 of Title 75 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes is amended to read: § 1361. Special motorcycle plates [for] **related to** veterans.

- (a) Honorably discharged veterans.—Upon application of any person who is an honorably discharged veteran of the armed forces of the United States, or a reserve component of the armed forces as defined in 51 Pa.C.S. § 7301 (relating to definitions), accompanied by a fee of \$20 which shall be in addition to the annual registration fee and by such documentation as the department shall require, the department shall issue to the person a special registration plate designating the vehicle as belonging to a person who is a veteran. The special registration plate may be used only on a motorcycle.
- (b) Honoring our veterans.--Upon application of any person, accompanied by a fee of \$35 which shall be in addition to the annual registration fee and by such documentation as the department shall require, the department shall issue to the person a special registration plate designating the motorcycle as belonging to a person who is honoring veterans of the armed forces of the United States. The special registration plate may be used only on a motorcycle. The Veterans' Trust Fund shall receive \$15 of the fee paid by the applicant for the plate.

Section 2. This act shall take effect in 90 days.
