SGT. ROBERT EUGENE GOODLIN MEMORIAL BRIDGE - DESIGNATION Act of Jul. 7, 2017, P.L. 298, No. 18 Cl. 87

An Act

Designating a bridge on that portion of State Route 1012, known as the Diamondville Bridge, Cherryhill Township, Indiana County, as the Sgt. Robert Eugene Goodlin Memorial Bridge.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

- Section 1. Sgt. Robert Eugene Goodlin Memorial Bridge.
- (a) Findings. -- The General Assembly finds and declares as follows:
 - (1) Sergeant Robert Eugene Goodlin grew up in Commodore, Indiana County, and attended Purchase Line High School.
 - (2) During the Vietnam Conflict, Sgt. Goodlin served in the United States Army as a sergeant with Company B, 2nd Battalion, 50th Infantry, 2nd Armored Division.
 - Battalion, 50th Infantry, 2nd Armored Division.

 (3) Among his decorations, Sgt. Goodlin was awarded the Bronze Star Medal and the Vietnam Service Medal with two Bronze Service Stars.
- (b) Designation.--The bridge located on State Route 1012, known as the Diamondville Bridge, Cherryhill Township, Indiana County, is designated as the Sgt. Robert Eugene Goodlin Memorial Bridge.
- (c) Signs.--The Department of Transportation shall erect and maintain appropriate signs displaying the name of the bridge to traffic in both directions on the bridge. Section 2. Effective date.

This act shall take effect in 60 days.
