## AN ACT

Amending Title 63 (Professions and Occupations (State Licensed)) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in powers and duties, further providing for civil penalties.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

- Section 1. Section 3108(a)(2) introductory paragraph and (i) of Title 63 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes are amended to read: § 3108. Civil penalties.
  - (a) Authorization.--
  - (2) The commissioner shall expunge the disciplinary record of a licensee, registrant, certificate holder or permit holder if the imposition of discipline was for a violation involving failure to complete continuing education requirements or practicing for six months or less on a lapsed license, registration, certificate or permit or for a violation otherwise specified in the schedule of civil penalties under paragraph (1), subject to the following:
    - (i) The licensee, registrant, certificate holder or permit holder must make written application to the commissioner for expungement not earlier than [four] **five** years from the final disposition of the disciplinary record.

Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
