

AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL NO. 831

1 Amend Bill, page 1, line 5, by inserting after "processions;"
2 and,

3 Amend Bill, page 1, lines 6 through 9, by striking out "; in"
4 in line 6, all of lines 7 and 8 and "further providing for
5 investigation by police officers" in line 9

6 Amend Bill, page 3, line 1, by striking out the period after
7 "flashers" and inserting

8 , if so equipped. A motorcycle driven in an organized
9 motorcycle procession shall bear a yellow bandana or cloth of at
10 least two square feet which is tied to the motorcycle mirror,
11 handlebars or similar frontal area for the purpose of
12 designating the motorcycle as part of the procession.

13 Amend Bill, page 3, lines 2 through 7, by striking out all of
14 lines 2 through 6 and "(d)" in line 7 and inserting

15 (c)

16 Amend Bill, page 3, line 13, by striking out "(e)" and
17 inserting

18 (d)

19 Amend Bill, page 3, line 14, by inserting after "of"

20 no fewer than 10

21 Amend Bill, page 3, lines 15 and 16, by striking out

22 "participating in an organized motorcycle ride in" in line 15

23 and all of line 16 and inserting

24 , not including the lead or trailing vehicle or motorcycle,
25 which meets all of the following requirements:

26 (1) The procession must be conducted between the hours

1 of 8 a.m. and sunset.

2 (2) The procession must be sponsored by a corporation or
3 a nonprofit organization.

4 (3) The procession must be conducted for memorial or
5 charitable purposes.

6 (4) At least 10% of the total number of motorcycle
7 drivers in the procession must wear a class 2 or higher
8 yellow reflective vest approved for use by the American
9 National Standards Institute.
