(b) Rescue of animal. -- No law enforcement officer, humane 12 13 society police officer or emergency responder, or the employer of a law enforcement officer, humane society police officer or 14 emergency responder shall be liable for damage to a motor 15 16 vehicle or the contents thereof caused by entry into the motor vehicle for the purpose of removing an animal, if the law 17 enforcement officer, humane society police officer or emergency 18 19 responder: 20 (1) Has a good faith, reasonable belief that the animal is in imminent danger of suffering harm if not immediately 21 22 removed from the motor vehicle. 23 (2) Makes a reasonable effort to locate the driver of 24 the motor vehicle prior to entry. 25 (3) Takes reasonable steps to ensure or restore the 26 well-being of the animal. 27 (4) Uses no more force than necessary under the circumstances to enter the motor vehicle. 28 29 (5) Leaves notice on or in the motor vehicle stating the reason entry was made, the name of the person and of the 30 31 person's employer, a telephone number and, if possible, the location where the animal may be retrieved. 32 (c) Limitation. -- A person shall not be immune from civil 33 34 liability for damage resulting from the entry if the person's actions constitute gross negligence, recklessness or willful or 35

1 <u>wanton misconduct.</u>

Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days. 2
