17       credit for weeks of total disability compensation paid prior  
18       to the effective date of this paragraph. This section shall  
19       not be construed to alter the requirements of section  
20       306(a.3) of the act.  
21       (2) For the purposes of determining the total number of  
22       weeks of partial disability compensation payable under  
23       section 306(a.3)(7) of the act, an insurer shall be given  
24       credit for weeks of partial disability compensation paid  
25       prior to the effective date of this paragraph.
