(d) A health insurer shall include the aggregate amount of rebates it has received from pharmacy benefit managers or drug manufacturers for the preceding calendar year in its annual statement filed with the department. The department shall verify that all such rebates are passed on to an insurer's customer in any rate filing with the department.

(e) Pharmacy benefit manager or insurer contracts with pharmacies may not contain a provision that prohibits pharmacists from disclosing information to a customer that would reduce the customer's out-of-pocket costs for prescription drugs.

The department may only include in the public report the aggregate amount of rebates paid for each drug and shall not disclose the identity of any individual payer.

(g) For purposes of this section , the term "manufacturer" does not include a person that engages in a business that only repackages or relabels prescription drugs.

Section 2. This act shall apply to any new or renewed contract on or after January 1, 2018.
