AN ACT

1 Amending the act of June 23, 1931 (P.L.932, No.317), entitled
2 "An act relating to cities of the third class; and amending,
3 revising, and consolidating the law relating thereto,"
4 providing for the immediate vesting of certain disabled
5 police officers in pension systems.

6 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
7 hereby enacts as follows:

8 Section 1. Section 4303 of the act of June 23, 1931
9 (P.L.932, No.317), known as The Third Class City Code, reenacted
10 and amended June 28, 1951 (P.L.662, No.164), is amended by
11 adding a subsection to read:

12 Section 4303. Allowances and Service Increments.--* * *

13 (e) Notwithstanding any provision of this act, any police
14 officer who becomes totally disabled due to injuries sustained
15 in the line of duty shall be deemed to be fully vested in the
16 police pension system, regardless of the actual number of years
17 of credited service.

18 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
