## A RESOLUTION

- Designating the week of May 12 through 18, 1991, as "Emergency
  Medical Services (EMS) Week" in Pennsylvania and proclaiming

- 11 WHEREAS, Advances in emergency medical care increase the
- 12 number of lives saved every year; and
- WHEREAS, The professional organizations of providers of

- 15 standardization of training and testing of emergency medical
- 16 personnel and reciprocal recognition of training and credentials
- 17 by the states; and
- 18 WHEREAS, The designation of "Emergency Medical Services (EMS)

- 2 injury prevention and what to do when confronted with a medical
