A RESOLUTION

1 Designating the week of May 12 through 18, 1991, as "Emergency  
2 Medical Services (EMS) Week" in Pennsylvania and proclaiming  
3 its theme as "The Team That Cares."

4 WHEREAS, The members of emergency medical services teams  
5 devote their lives to saving the lives of others; and

6 WHEREAS, Emergency medical services teams consist of  
7 emergency physicians, nurses, emergency medical technicians,  
8 paramedics, educators and administrators; and

9 WHEREAS, The citizens of Pennsylvania benefit daily from the  
10 knowledge and skill of these trained individuals; and

11 WHEREAS, Advances in emergency medical care increase the  
12 number of lives saved every year; and

13 WHEREAS, The professional organizations of providers of  
14 emergency medical services teams encourage national  
15 standardization of training and testing of emergency medical  
16 personnel and reciprocal recognition of training and credentials  
17 by the states; and

18 WHEREAS, The designation of "Emergency Medical Services (EMS)

1 Week" will serve to educate the people of Pennsylvania about  
2 injury prevention and what to do when confronted with a medical  
3 emergency; therefore be it

4       RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives recognize the  
5 value and the accomplishments of emergency medical services  
6 teams by designating May 12 through 18, 1991, as "Emergency  
7 Medical Services (EMS) Week" in Pennsylvania and proclaiming its  
8 theme as "The Team That Cares."
