AN ACT

Amending Title 25 (Elections) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in voter registration, further providing for 2 methods of voter registration, providing for same-day voter registration and further providing for preparation and 3 4 distribution of applications. 5 6 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 7 hereby enacts as follows: Section 1. Section 1321 of Title 25 of the Pennsylvania 8 Consolidated Statutes is amended by adding a paragraph to read: 10 § 1321. Methods of voter registration. 11 An individual qualified to register to vote under section 12 1301(a) (relating to qualifications to register) may apply to 13 register as follows: * * * 14 15 (5) Under section 1325.1 (relating to same-day voter 16 registration).

Section 2. Title 25 is amended by adding a section to read:

18 § 1325.1. Same-day voter registration.

- 1 (a) General rule. -- A qualified elector may register on
- 2 <u>election day by appearing in person at the polling place for the</u>
- 3 election district in which the individual maintains residence,
- 4 completing and submitting a voter registration application to
- 5 the judge of elections and providing proof of identification and
- 6 residence.
- 7 (b) Acceptable forms of identification. -- In addition to
- 8 providing a completed voter registration application, an
- 9 applicant must provide a valid form of identification, including
- 10 any of the following government-issued forms of identification:
- 11 (1) A valid driver's license or identification card
- issued by the Department of Transportation.
- 13 (2) A valid identification card issued by another agency
- of the Commonwealth.
- 15 (3) A valid identification card issued by the United
- 16 States Government.
- 17 (4) A valid United States passport.
- 18 (5) A valid United States Armed Forces identification
- 19 <u>card.</u>
- 20 (c) Procedures for same-day registration. --
- 21 (1) Upon certifying the eligibility of the qualified
- 22 elector, the judge of elections at the polling place shall
- issue a provisional ballot, provided by the county election
- 24 board, which is to be completed by the qualified elector and
- 25 <u>sealed in an envelope along with the voter registration</u>
- 26 application.
- 27 (2) Within 10 days of an election, the department shall
- approve or deny a voter registration application pursuant to
- 29 the provisions established in section 1328 (relating to
- 30 approval of registration applications).

- 1 (3) The provisional ballot may not be counted until the
- 2 <u>department has approved the voter registration application.</u>
- 3 (4) The elector applicant shall be notified in writing
- 4 <u>by the department as to the approval or denial of a voter</u>
- 5 <u>registration application.</u>
- 6 Section 3. Section 1327(c) of Title 25 is amended by adding
- 7 a paragraph to read:
- 8 § 1327. Preparation and distribution of applications.
- 9 * * *
- 10 (c) Distribution.--
- 11 * * *
- 12 <u>(7) The secretary shall print and distribute same-day</u>
- 13 <u>voter registration applications to all polling places</u>
- 14 <u>throughout this Commonwealth. Along with the distribution of</u>
- the voter registration applications, the secretary shall also
- include instructions to inform the applicant of the same-day
- 17 voter registration application process and the process for
- 18 counting the applicant's vote and verifying the applicant's
- 19 eligibility.

- 21 Section 4. This act shall take effect immediately.
