## AN ACT

- 1 Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- 2 Statutes, providing for special license plates for recipients
- 3 of the Medal of Honor.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Title 75, act of November 25, 1970 (P.L.707,
- 7 No.230), known as the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, is
- 8 amended by adding a section to read:
- 9 § 1345. Special plates for recipients of the Medal of Honor.
- 10 Upon application of any person who is a recipient of the
- 11 Medal of Honor, the department shall issue to such person a
- 12 special registration plate designating the vehicle so licensed
- 13 as belonging to a person who is a recipient of the Medal of
- 14 Honor. The plate shall have a light blue background interspersed
- 15 with 13 white stars. The center of the plate shall bear a golden
- 16 bronze replica of the appropriate medal. The initials of each
- 17 recipient shall be embossed in red to the left of the medal and
- 18 the letters "CMH" (for Congressional Medal of Honor) shall be

- 1 <u>embossed in red to the right of the medal.</u>
- Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days. 2
