AN ACT

- Amending the act of April 9, 1929 (P.L.177, No.175), entitled "An act providing for and reorganizing the conduct of the 2 3 executive and administrative work of the Commonwealth by the 4 Executive Department thereof and the administrative departments, boards, commissions, and officers thereof, 6 including the boards of trustees of State Normal Schools, or 7 Teachers Colleges; abolishing, creating, reorganizing or 8 authorizing the reorganization of certain administrative departments, boards, and commissions; defining the powers and 9 10 duties of the Governor and other executive and administrative officers, and of the several administrative departments, 11 12 boards, commissions, and officers; fixing the salaries of the 13 Governor, Lieutenant Governor, and certain other executive and administrative officers; providing for the appointment of 14 15 certain administrative officers, and of all deputies and 16 other assistants and employes in certain departments, boards, and commissions; and prescribing the manner in which the 17 18 number and compensation of the deputies and all other 19 assistants and employes of certain departments, boards and 20 commissions shall be determined," requiring the filing of 21 additional materials on contracts with corporations.
- The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 23 hereby enacts as follows:
- Section 1. Section 1104 of the act of April 9, 1929
- 25 (P.L.177, No.175), known as The Administrative Code of 1929,
- 26 added December 9, 1980 (P.L.1333, No.244), is amended to read:
- 27 Section 1104. Copies of Contracts to be Furnished to the

- 1 State Treasurer.--(a) Whenever any department, board,
- 2 commission, agency, instrumentality, authority or institution of
- 3 the Commonwealth shall enter into any contract involving any
- 4 property, real, personal or mixed of any kind or description or
- 5 any contract for personal services where the consideration
- 6 involved in said contract is five thousand dollars (\$5,000) or
- 7 more, a copy of said contract shall be furnished by the
- 8 <u>contracting agency</u> to the Treasury Department [within ten (10)
- 9 days after the contract is executed on behalf of the
- 10 Commonwealth or otherwise becomes an obligation of the
- 11 Commonwealth]. If the contract has been executed with a
- 12 corporation, it shall include an attachment specifying the names
- 13 of the corporation's chairman of the board, chief executive
- 14 officer, treasurer and those individuals who held more than ten
- 15 per centum (10%) of the corporation's preferred or common stock
- 16 on the date the contract was executed.
- 17 (b) Every contract filed pursuant to subsection (a) shall
- 18 remain on file with the Treasury Department for a period of one
- 19 year or until all disbursements have been made on the contracts,
- 20 whichever is longer and shall be made available for public
- 21 inspection and copies made available at cost to any individual
- 22 who requests them.
- 23 (c) No contract subject to subsection (a) shall be issued by
- 24 any department, board, commission, agency, instrumentality,
- 25 <u>authority or institution of the Commonwealth unless a copy of</u>
- 26 the contract has been filed by the contracting agency with the
- 27 Treasury Department. The contract documents and the notice to
- 28 proceed shall include a statement from the Treasury Department
- 29 <u>acknowledging receipt of a copy of the contract.</u>
- 30 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
