- 7 mother, Marie, until he met up with coach Al Mitchell, who
- 8 trains and advises him to this day; and
- 9 WHEREAS, Mr. Reid won a convincing unanimous decision over
- 10 previously unbeaten James Coker in 1998 running his record to a
- 11 perfect 11-0 and earning him the WBC Continental Americas title;

- 13 WHEREAS, Mr. Reid won the WBA Super Welterweight crown via a

- 1 12-round decision over France's Laurent Boudouani in 1999;
