In the House of Representatives, May 11, 1976

1 WHEREAS, The Supreme Court of Pennsylvania by virtue of
2 Article V, section 10(c) of the Constitution of the Commonwealth
3 of Pennsylvania is vested with general powers of judicial
4 administration over all courts and employees of said courts
5 within the Commonwealth; and

6 WHEREAS, The Supreme Court recently promulgated rules
7 governing the standards of conduct affecting constables in
8 addition to other persons; and

9 WHEREAS, These rules governing the code of conduct affect not
10 only the performance of the official duties of the constables
11 but restrict their private liberties as well; now therefore be
12 it

13 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives urge the Supreme
14 Court of Pennsylvania to reconsider the severity of its action
15 and to repeal the existing restrictive rules relating to
16 constables; and be it further

17 RESOLVED, That copies of this resolution be delivered to the

1 Chief Justice and all associate justices of the Supreme Court of
2 Pennsylvania.
