A RESOLUTION

1 Providing for the Transportation Committee to investigate the
2 procedures for motor vehicle salvage within Pennsylvania.

3 WHEREAS, The current procedures for motor vehicle salvage
4 involve great expense for municipalities and for State
5 government; and

6 WHEREAS, It appears that certain other states may have less
7 costly and more efficient procedures for salvage; and

8 WHEREAS, It would be helpful to compare Pennsylvania's
9 salvage procedures with those of other states; therefore be it

10 RESOLVED, That the Transportation Committee of the House of
11 Representatives undertake a study of motor vehicle salvage laws
12 and regulations of this Commonwealth and compare the same with
13 salvage procedures of other states; and be it further

14 RESOLVED, That the committee may hold hearings, take
15 testimony and make its investigations at such places as it deems
16 necessary in this Commonwealth. Each member of the committee
17 shall have power to administer oaths and affirmations to

1 witnesses appearing before the committee; and be it further
2 RESOLVED, That the committee make a report of its findings
3 and recommendations to the House of Representatives as soon as
4 possible.
