A RESOLUTION

- 1 Memorializing the President of the United States and Congress to 2 promote and strengthen steps to save the rain forests.
- 3 WHEREAS, The House of Representatives is becoming
- 4 increasingly concerned that the tropical rain forests are being
- 5 destroyed at a rate of between 13.5 million and 55 million acres
- 6 a year; and
- 7 WHEREAS, It is feared that further destruction will lead to
- 8 the elimination of hundreds of thousands of species of plants
- 9 and animals; and
- 10 WHEREAS, Rain forests are an important source of medicinal
- 11 plants, and approximately 121 prescription drugs are derived
- 12 from plants which have their origins in rain forests; and
- 13 WHEREAS, Rain forests are storehouses of evolutionary
- 14 achievement and are increasingly invaluable to humankind in our
- 15 search for the mysteries of life; and
- 16 WHEREAS, Rain forests play a major role in the way the sun's
- 17 heat is distributed around the globe, and any disturbance could
- 18 produce climatic chaos; and

- 1 WHEREAS, It is imperative that something be done before the
- 2 damage to the rain forests is irreversible; therefore be it
- 3 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives memorialize the
- 4 President and Congress to take whatever steps are necessary to
- 5 protect the rain forests from further destruction; and be it
- 6 further
- 7 RESOLVED, That copies of this resolution be transmitted to
- 8 the President of the United States and the presiding officers of
- 9 each house of Congress and to each member of Congress from
- 10 Pennsylvania.
