AN ACT

1 To require the country of origin to be displayed on every
2 passenger car sold in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania; and
3 providing penalties.

4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
5 hereby enacts as follows:

6 Section 1. (a) It shall be unlawful to sell or offer for
7 sale a new passenger car in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
8 without the information required in section 2.

9 (b) It shall be unlawful for a manufacturer or assembler of
10 a passenger car to deliver for sale a passenger car in the
11 Commonwealth of Pennsylvania without attaching to the passenger
12 car the information required in section 2.

13 Section 2. Every new passenger car sold, offered for sale or
14 delivered for sale within the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania shall
15 include in letters at least two inches high the country in which
16 the passenger car is manufactured or assembled as stated on the
17 manufacturer's identification plate. Such information shall be

1 temporarily displayed on the exterior of the passenger car so
2 that it is clearly visible at the time of the sale.

3 Section 3. It shall be unlawful for any person to remove the
4 information required in section 2.

5 Section 4. Persons willfully violating this act shall be
6 guilty of a summary offense and shall, upon conviction, be
7 subject to a fine of \$500 or ten days imprisonment or both.

8 Section 5. This act shall take effect immediately.
