## AN ACT

- Amending the act of July 31, 1968 (P.L.805, No.247), entitled, as amended, "An act to empower cities of the second class A, and third class, boroughs, incorporated towns, townships of the first and second classes including those within a county of the second class and counties of the second class A through eighth classes, individually or jointly, to plan 6 7 their development and to govern the same by zoning, 8 subdivision and land development ordinances, planned residential development and other ordinances, by official 9 maps, by the reservation of certain land for future public 10 purpose and by the acquisition of such land; providing for 11 12 the establishment of planning commissions, planning 13 departments, planning committees and zoning hearing boards, authorizing them to charge fees, make inspections and hold 14 15 public hearings; providing for appropriations, appeals to 16 courts and penalties for violations; and repealing acts and 17 parts of acts, "exempting agencies and personnel from civil 18 liability in the performance of their duties.
- 19 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 20 hereby enacts as follows:
- 21 The act of July 31, 1968 (P.L.805, No.247), known Section 1.
- 22 as the "Pennsylvania Municipalities Planning Code," is amended
- 23 by adding a section to read:
- 24 Section 108. Exemption From Civil Liability. -- No
- 25 municipality or planning agency or officer, employe or agent of

- 1 <u>a municipality or planning agency shall be liable for damages in</u>
- 2 any civil action instituted for loss or injury sustained from
- 3 official actions or decisions of the municipality, agency or
- 4 person or to compel or restrain official action by the
- 5 <u>municipality</u>, <u>agency or person</u>.
- 6 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
